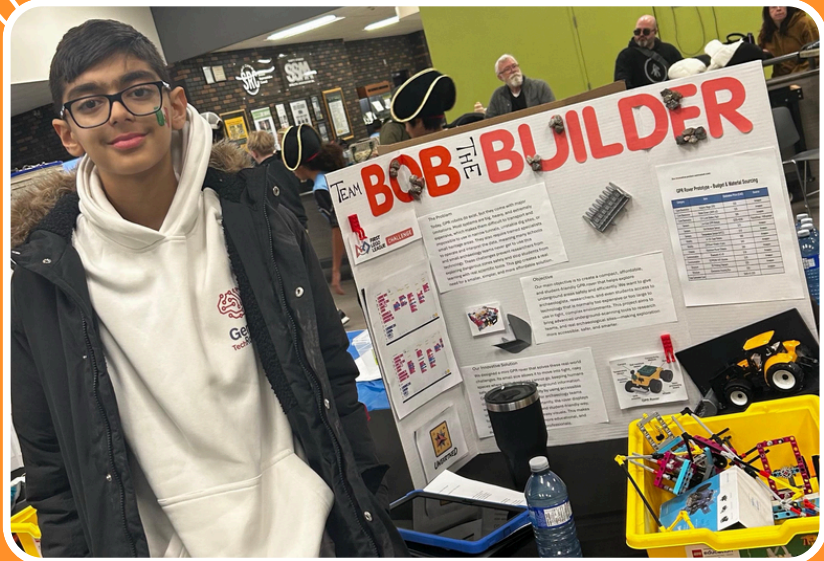


December's Highlights

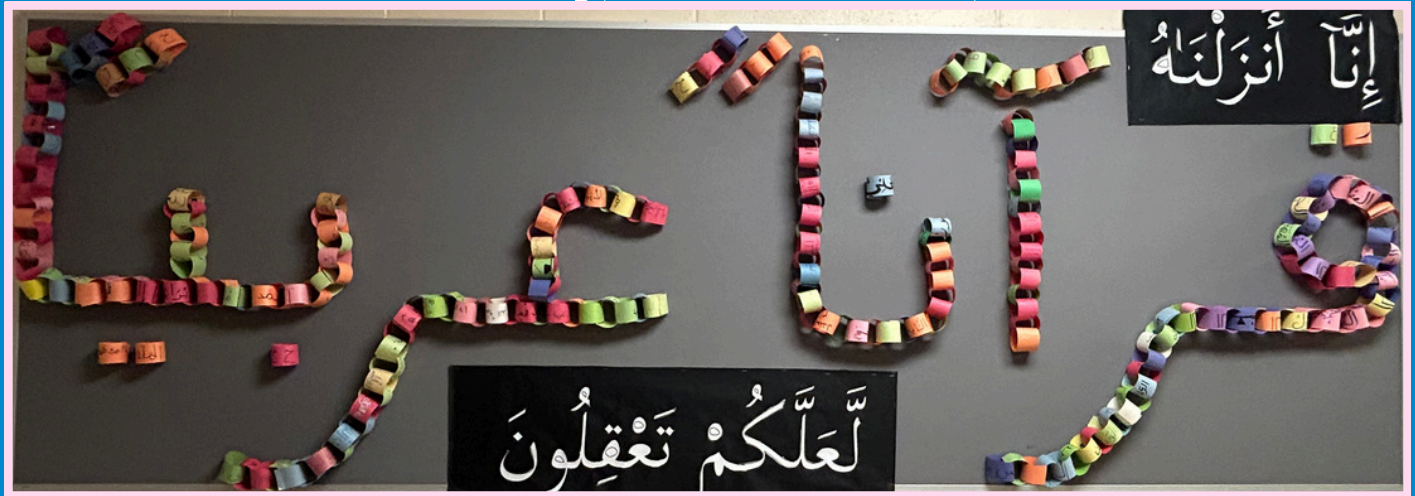

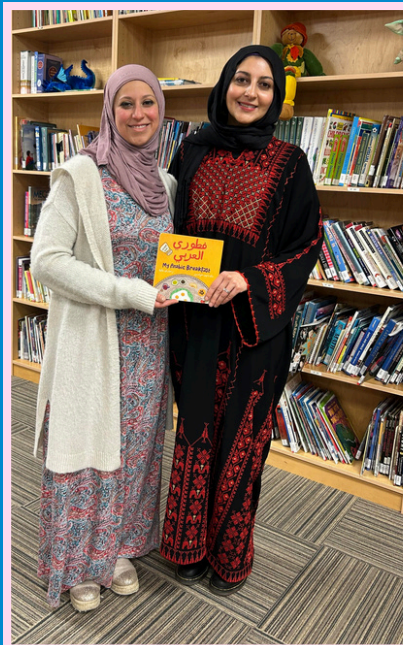

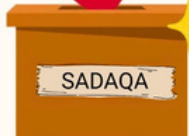
