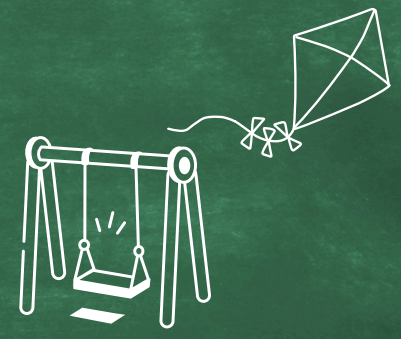

The Teddy Bear hospital guides students through different stations like allergies, asthma, and imaging.



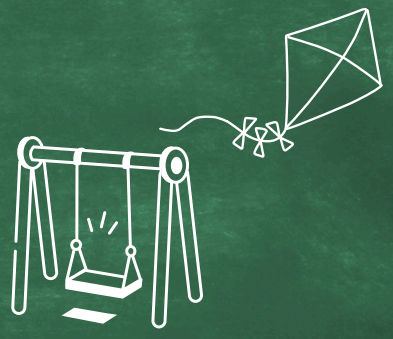
Buxton National Historic Site

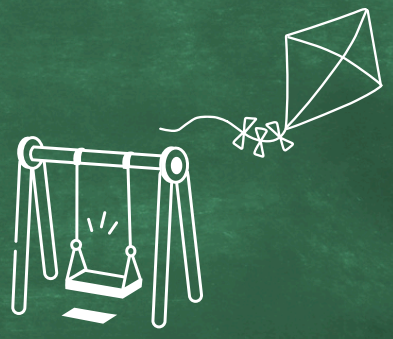
World Bee Day

Students learned the roles of bees and their importance for a sustainable environment. The students decorated wooden bees for a bee-utiful display.

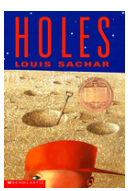

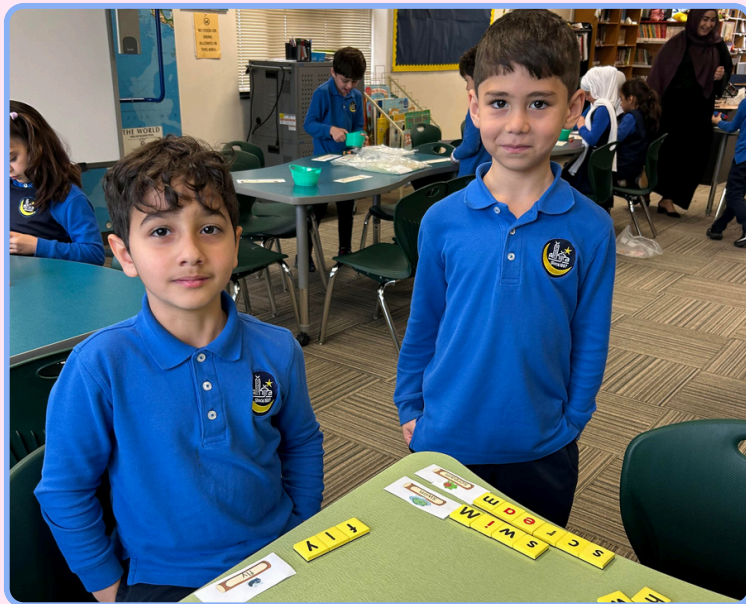


LIBRARY CORNER
